

Descendants of Stephen Woodward and Hannah Clement

Generation One

1. Stephen¹ Woodward was born in Massachusetts. He married Hannah Clement, perhaps the daughter of Jonathan Clement and Sarah Watts.

Several derivative sources would have us believe that the Stephen Woodward who married Hannah Clement, was born 9 May 1716/17, the son of Ezekiel and Hannah Woodward, in Gloucester, Massachusetts.¹

It is apparent that a Stephen Woodward married a Hannah Clement. The question is which Stephen Woodward? If Hannah's husband was born 9 March 1716/17, then he would have been 41 years old when his son Eliphalet was born and 57 when his last son, Jesse, was born. Obviously these are not impossible dates, but it is very unusual for a man to start his family when he is forty or more years old. Perhaps Hannah Clement was not his first wife indicating that Stephen had an earlier family, not yet identified.

In all likelihood Stephen's wife was the Hannah Clement born 24 March 1732 in Haverhill, Essex County, Massachusetts, daughter of Jonathon Clement and Sarah Watts.² Their marriage was not located within the Haverhill Vital Records.

Some time in 1759, probably early April, Stephen moved his family from Haverhill, Massachusetts to Plaistow, New Hampshire (bordering towns on the state line). Apparently, Stephen had no visible means of support because on 17 April 1759 Stephen, Hannah, and Eliphalet, their son, were warned out of town back to Haverhill, from whence they came.³

Apparently the family did not return to Haverhill since the court records of Province of New Hampshire provide evidence that Stephen Woodward of Plastow [sic], laborer, wrote a promissory note to Samuel White on 16 April 1761 for five pounds six shillings and eight pence which he was to repay on the 21st day of April 1761. Stephen did not pay the note when it was due and Samuel White sued him for the money on the 13th of February 1762.⁴

At a Plaistow town meeting 12 September 1769, Stephen Woodard was paid for work at "shingling" on the repair of the parsonage.⁵

There is a Stephen Woodard enumerated in Plaistow during the 1790 federal census. His house hold contains 1 free white male age 16 and upwards, 1 free white male under 16, and 3 free white females.⁶

- + 3 ii. Stephen Woodward, born 11 May 1760⁹ at Plaistow, Rockingham County, New Hampshire; married Lydia Gage.
- 4 iii. Edna Woodward was born on 2 September 1762 at Plaistow, Rockingham County, New Hampshire.
- 5 iv. James Woodward was born on 26 June 1765 at Plaistow, Rockingham County, New Hampshire.
- 6 v. Hannah Woodward was born on 26 July 1767 at Plaistow, Rockingham County, New Hampshire. She married Mr. Crowell at Springfield, Sullivan County, New Hampshire.²
- 7 vi. Betsey Woodward was born on 5 September 1769 at Plaistow, Rockingham County, New Hampshire.
- 8 vii. Sarah Woodward was born on 25 February 1772 at Plaistow, Rockingham County, New Hampshire.

- 10 ix. Tamar Woodward was born on 19 September 1779 at Plaistow, Rockingham County, New Hampshire. She died on 17 November 1853 at New London, Merrimack County, New Hampshire, at age 74.¹⁰

Generation Two

2. Eliphalet² Woodward (Stephen¹) was born on 28 May 1758¹¹, probably in Haverhill, Essex County, Massachusetts.¹² He married Martha Gage on 9 or 10 December 1779 at No. Parish Congregational Church, Haverhill, Essex County, Massachusetts.¹³ He died on 23 February 1826 at New London, Merrimack County, New Hampshire, at age 67.¹⁴

Martha Gage, daughter of Daniel Gage and Ruth Kimball, was born 11 July, 1758, in Pelham, Rockingham County (now in Hillsborough), New Hampshire, and died 30 September 1847, probably in New London.¹⁵

In 1759, young Eliphalet's parents moved from Haverhill, Massachusetts, across the state line to Plaistow, New Hampshire. The area in which they settled was split off from Plaistow and called Atkinson. Sometime before 1787 Eliphalet and his brother Stephen removed to Sutton, Hillsborough County (now Merrimack), New Hampshire from

Sandown, settling on adjoining farms in the northwest part of the town, near New London.¹⁶ In 1798 Eliphalet moved into New London where he lived until his death. He served in the Revolution.¹⁷

Eliphalet Woodward enlisted in Captain Gilman's Company immediately after the battle of Bunker Hill for a term of eight months in Col. Poor's Regiment. Previously he had served Capt. Phillip Tilton's Company in the same regiment for the term of one year. On the 4th of March 1843, Eliphalet Woodward, former private in the Massachusetts line of the Continental Army, was listed on the rolls to receive a Revolutionary War pension. When he enlisted in 1778 for seventeen months he was a resident of Plaistow, Rockingham County, New Hampshire. He first filed for a military pension on 14 May 1818 from New London, New Hampshire.¹⁸

On the 6th day of September 1820, he took an oath in the Court of Common Pleas for the county of Hillsborough, New Hampshire listing Eliphalet's whole estate and income (excepting his necessary clothing and bedding) as

Eliphalet also indicated he and his wife, Martha, received living assistance from James Woodward.¹⁹

- 12 ii. Abigail Woodward was born on 30 November 1782 at Haverhill, Essex County, Massachusetts.²⁴ She married Cyrus Taylor 23 January 1804 in Lebanon, Grafton County.²⁵ She died on 25 March 1873 at Ohio at age 90.²⁶
- 13 iii. Eliphalet Woodward was born on 29 November 1784 at Plaistow, Rockingham County, New Hampshire.²⁷ He died on 8 May 1807, probably in New Hampshire, at age 22.²⁸
- + 14 iv. Ednah Woodward, born 20 March 1787 at Sutton, Merrimack County, New Hampshire; married Nathaniel Bunker, 13 August 1809, in New London.²⁹
- + 15 v. James Woodward, born 3 March 1789 at Sutton, Merrimack County, New Hampshire; married Dolly Dole.
- 16 vi. Daniel Woodward was born on 24 March 1791, probably in New Hampshire.³⁰ He died on 31 March 1791, probably in New Hampshire.³¹
- 17 vii. Amos Woodward was born on 31 May 1792, probably in New Hampshire.³² He married Sylvia Sargent, daughter of Amasa Sargent and Susanna Shepard, on 23 February 1819, probably in Lebanon, Grafton County, New Hampshire.³³ He died on 19 December 1873, probably in Hanover, Grafton County, New Hampshire, at age 81.³⁴
- 18 viii. Rhoda Woodward was born on 6 February 1794.³⁵ She died on 17 February 1794, probably in New Hampshire.³⁶
- + 19 ix. John King Woodward, born 9 July 1795 at Sutton, Merrimack County, New Hampshire; married Mehitable K. Sargent.
- + 20 x. Isaac Woodward, born 15 March 1797 at Sutton, Merrimack County, New Hampshire; married Hannah K. Sargent.
- 21 xi. Mary Eaton Woodward was born on 27 March 1799 at New London, Merrimack County, New Hampshire.³⁷ She married Stephen Sargent, son of John Sargent and Susanna Johnson, on 12

October 1819.³⁸ She died on 19 May 1828 at age 29.³⁹

3. Stephen² Woodward (Stephen¹) was born on 11 May 1760 at Plaistow, Rockingham County, New Hampshire.⁴⁰ He married Lydia Gage,⁴¹ daughter of Daniel Gage and Ruth Kimball, on 31 December 1782 at No. Parish Congregational Church, Haverhill, Essex County, Massachusetts. He died in 1840, probably in New London, Merrimack County, New Hampshire.⁴²

Sometime before 1787 Stephen and his brother Eliphalet removed to Sutton, Hillsborough County (now Merrimack), New Hampshire from Sandown, settling on adjoining farms in the northwest part of the town, near New London.⁴³

his first wife, Polly, cousin of Ruth, on 27 October 1829 in New London.⁵¹ She died in August 1864 at age 66.⁵²

- 30 ix. Lydia Woodward was born on 7 June 1799. She married Jonathan Moore on 12 February 1826 in Sutton.⁵³ She died in January 1827 at age 27.⁵⁴
- + 31 x. Matthew Woodward, born 25 March 1804 at Sutton, Merrimack County, New Hampshire; married Julia S. Whittaker.

9. Jesse² Woodward (Stephen¹) was born on 24 June 1774 at Plaistow, Rockingham County, New Hampshire.⁵⁵ He married Bashabee Stevens at Springfield, Sullivan County, New Hampshire.

Jesse, like his father, seems to have disappeared off the face of the earth. Bashabee is found within land transactions as early as 1837.

Children of Jesse² Woodward and Bashabee Stevens were as follows:

- + 32 i. Daniel Saunders³ Woodward, born 11 July 1796 at Springfield, Sullivan County, New Hampshire;⁵⁶ married first Dorcas Adams; and married second Lucy Spalding.

Generation Three

11. Joseph Gage³ Woodward (Eliphalet², Stephen¹) was born on 19 December 1780 at Atkinson, Rockingham County, New Hampshire.⁵⁹ He married Polly Dole, daughter of John Dole and Molly Pingree, on 24 October 1805, probably in New Hampshire.⁶⁰ He married Mrs. Betsey (--?--) Johnson in 1822.⁶¹ He died on 19 August 1863 at Sutton, Merrimack County, New Hampshire, at age 82.⁶²

After his marriage, Capt. Joseph G. Woodward settled in Sutton, New Hampshire where he cleared what is now [1899] the James Prescott farm. Joseph built the Solon Cooper house where he died. His youngest son Amos resided there until the death of his mother in 1865 when he sold the house to Micajah Morgan.⁶³

Children of Joseph Gage³ Woodward and Polly Dole were as follows:⁶⁴

- 35 i. Marcus⁴ Woodward was born on 12 January 1807, probably in New Hampshire. He married Olive Bryant at Stoneham, Middlesex County, Massachusetts. On 14 September 1850, the family of Marcus Woodward was enumerated in Stoneham, Middlesex County, Massachusetts.⁶⁵ In 1860 the family was still residing in Stoneham.⁶⁶
- + 36 ii. John D. Woodward, born 22 August 1808, probably in New Hampshire; married, first Sally Sargent; and married, second, Dolly Sargent.
- + 37 iii. Mary Jane Woodward, married David Gage Stickney.
- 38 iv. Martha A. Woodward married John Morey 13 November 1833 in Wilmot, Merrimack County, New Hampshire.⁶⁷
- + 39 v. Drusilla Woodward, married, first, Moses Cilley and, second, married Micajah Morgan.
- 40 vi. Milton Woodward.
- + 41 vii. Salome Woodward, married Enoch Messer.
- 42 viii. Joseph Woodward.

Children of Joseph Gage³ Woodward and Mrs. Betsey (--?--) Johnson are as follows:

- 43 i. Lawson⁴ Woodward married Miss Ellsworth.⁶⁸ He lived at Oregon. This may be the Lawson Woodward who owned land in New London, New Hampshire, which was sold by Marcus E. Sargent Deputy Sheriff for Merrimack County for a judgment made in favor of Amos Page of New London on 31 December 1851.⁶⁹
- 44 ii. Eliza D. Woodward married Edwin Ruthven Sargent on 3 September 1844.⁷⁰
- 45 iii. Amos Woodward. After the death of Capt. Joseph Gage Woodward, Amos, resided in the Solon Cooper house until the death of his mother in 1865 when he sold the house to Micajah Morgan (his brother-in-law). That year Amos removed to Wisconsin and then to Minnesota. In 1899 Amos was residing in Lyons Nebraska.⁷¹

14. Ednah³ Woodward (Eliphalet², Stephen¹) was born on 20 March 1787 at Sutton, Merrimack County, New Hampshire.⁷² She married Nathaniel Bunker, son of Benjamin Bunker and Betsey Daniels, on 13 August 1809, New London, Merrimack County, New Hampshire.⁷³ She died on 28 August 1835, probably in Ohio, at age 48.⁷⁴

15. James³ Woodward (Eliphalet², Stephen¹) was born on 3 March 1789 at Sutton, Merrimack County, New Hampshire.⁷⁶ He married Dolly Dole, daughter of John Dole and Molly Pingree, on 8 December 1814, probably in New Hampshire.⁷⁷ He died on 28 April 1872 at Ohio at age 83.⁷⁸

Daniel Saunders³ Woodward (Jesse², Stephen¹) was born on 11 July 1796 at Springfield, Sullivan County, New Hampshire.^{31,32,33} He married Dorcas Adams, daughter of Enoch Adams and Elizabeth Russell, on 8 July 1828 at Salisbury, Merrimack County, New Hampshire.¹⁰⁸ He married Lucy Spalding on 14 June 1879 at Franklin, Merrimack County, New Hampshire.³² He died on 18 January 1892 at Hill, Merrimack County, New Hampshire, at age 95, and buried at Franklin Cemetery, Franklin, Merrimack County, New Hampshire.¹⁰⁹

Daniel S. Woodward, yeoman of Salisbury conveyed land in Salisbury to Kimball Woodward of Salisbury on 7 April 1834. The land was described as lying in Salisbury it being a part of lot No. forty one in the third range and is bounded as follows. Beginning at stake and stones standing eight feet north of the Northwest corner of a house built by Joseph Webster, thence south ten rods to a stake & stones thence east eight rods to stake and stones thence north ten rods to stake & stones. thence west eight rods to the first mentioned bounds to contain eighty rods same more or less. The deed was signed by Daniel S. Woodward and witnessed by Joshua S. Bean and Samuel Smith. The deed was recorded on 24 April 1834.¹¹⁰

On 17 April 1841, Nathan and Polly Kilborn of Boscawen, conveyed twenty five acres, more or less in Boscawen to Daniel S. Woodward, yeomen, of Boscawen for consideration of four hundred and fifty dollars. The parcel was bounded on the east by the highway leading from the End of Pleasant Street in Boscawen to the South Road Village in Salisbury on the South by land of Benjamin Smith on the west by land of Garland Calef and on the north by the line of the town of Boscawen excepting one acre of land now owned by Kimball Woodward. The tract was the same as the tract and building conveyed to Kilborn by Kimball Woodward by deed dated the tenth day of February 1838. The deed signed by Nathan and Polly Kilborn was witnessed by John Fellows and James S. Fellows and recorded 27 April 1841.¹¹¹

33. Kimball³ Woodward (Jesse², Stephen¹) was born circa 1802. He married Nancy Moody circa 1824. Kimball died intestate on 20 June 1845 at the age of 43 in Salisbury.¹³⁰ He was buried at Salisbury South Road Cemetery.¹³¹

Kimball's estate was probated in July 1845 in Merrimack County, New Hampshire. Administration of this estate was granted to Valentine Little of Salisbury.¹³²

To date there is no primary evidence demonstrating that Kimball Woodward was the son of Jesse and Bashabee Stevens. However, he is found interacting with Bashabee and Daniel S Woodward in land transactions and his son, Oliver, was enumerated with the family of Daniel S. Woodward in 1850.

Kimball Woodward of Salisbury purchased 2 parcels of land from John B. Smith, also of Salisbury, on 24 December 1831 for two hundred dollars. The first parcel of land was the northeasterly part of a lot on the homestead farm formerly owned by Folsom Bean now deceased and was conveyed by him to Amos Bean and is bounded as follows; beginning at the northwest corner of s^d lot at the town line thence southwardly on the line of said lot fifty rods thence eastwardly twenty eight rods to the middle of the brook thence following the middle of the brook to the town line thence following the town line twenty seven rods to the first mentioned bound to contain eight acres and sixty rods. The land was situated in Boscawen. The second parcel adjoined the previous parcel and bounded beginning at the northeastwardly corner of the lot formerly owned by Col. Richard Kent running southwardly on the eastwardly line of said lot sixty rods thence westwardly on said lot until it shall contain ten acres by measure the southwardly line of the same to be parallel with the town line meaning to convey as aforesaid all the land which John B. Smith owned in the town of Boscawen. This second parcel had been convey to Smith by Benjamin Baker late of Salisbury, deceased, and had been conveyed to s^d Baker by Amos Bean and Daniel Calef reserving the right to take from s^d land such pine trees as may com within the contract which Smith had made with Abel Baker, Esquire. The deed was signed by John B. Smith and Hannah Smith and witnessed by Eliphalet Little and Cyrus Smith. The deed was recorded in Merrimack County on 2 January 1832.¹³³

The land was described as lying in Salisbury it being a part of lot No. forty one in the third range and is bounded as follows. John Elliot, of Boscawen, conveyed a parcel of land in Boscawen to Kimball Woodward, gentleman, of Salisbury on 21 February 1835. The parcel contained about four acres bounded on the east by the new road leading from Salisbury South Road Village to Coner[?] Hill in Boscawen on the South by land Royal Hale on the west by land of David Calef and on the north by land of the said Woodward. The deed, recorded 22 February 1836 was signed by John Elliot and witnessed by Jonathan H Clement and Israel W. Kelly.¹³⁵

The land was bounded at the Northeast corner of a piece of land conveyed to Couch by Nehemiah Cogswell being a part of the Enoch Elliot farm (so called) lying on the west side of the road leading from the fourth New Hampshire Turnpike road in Salisbury to Pleasant Street in Boscawen, thence on said road southerly twenty rods, thence Westerly eight rods, thence Northerly twenty rods on a parallel line with said road thence Easterly eight rods to the bound first mentioned. Samuel D. Couch signed the deed which was witnessed by Samuel Allen and Nathaniel Beem. The deed was recorded 6 May 1835.¹³⁶

Attorney Alfred Kittridge of Bradford, Essex County, Commonwealth of Massachusetts, conveyed property to Kimball Woodward of Boscawen, Merrimack Co., New Hampshire, yeoman for consideration of twenty eight dollars on 5 August 1835. The land, owned in by Alfred Kittridge and his wife, Mary E. Kittridge, was located in Boscawen bounded beginning by the road leading from Salisbury South Road Village to Pleasant Street in Boscawen and lying on the west side of said road sometimes called Moulton road thence running on the west side of said road to the middle of the Brook which bounded said Kimball Woodward's land thence up the middle of said Brook to the Boscawen town line thence easterly on the said town line to the road and bound first mentioned containing one acre and one half more-or-less. The deed recorded 22 Feb 1836, was signed by Kittridge and his wife, and witnessed by Charles White and Mary C. Sargent.¹³⁷

On 12 December 1835, Royal Hale of Boscawen conveyed land in Boscawen to Kimball Woodward, yeoman, also of Boscawen. The land, containing two acres more or less, began at the northwest corner bound of land conveyed to Hale by Abigail Gookin, thence running southerly on land of Garland Calef sixteen rods and one half rod to stake and stones thence easterly by land now in the possession of David Gile to the highway leading from Boscawen to Salisbury South Road thence northerly on the west line of said highway to bound of said Kimball Woodward's land thence westerly on said Kimball Woodward land to the bound first mentioned. The deed, signed by Royal Hale (his wife Susan relinquished here right to dower) was witnessed by David Comer and Hez^h Fellows. The deed was recorded 22 February 1836.¹³⁸

On 31 July 1837, Kimball Woodward of Boscawen conveyed to Bashaba Woodward, widow woman, of Salisbury an acre of land for one hundred and seventy dollars. The land was in Boscawen and was described as beginning at the northeast corner of a piece of land conveyed to Kimball Woodward by Samuel D. Couch, it being a part of the Enoch Elliot farm so called, lying on the west side of the road leading from the fourth New Hampshire Turnpike road in Salisbury to pleasant Street in Boscawen, thence on said southerly twenty rods, thence westerly eight-rods, thence Northerly twenty rods on a parallel line with said road, thence easterly eight rods to the bound first mentioned. The deed signed by Kimball Woodward was witnessed by Sally Rollins and Diana Woodward. The deed was recorded on 6 November 1837.¹³⁹

Kimball Woodward of Boscawen was involved in yet another land transaction when he mortgaged land owned by Ira Sweatt of Boscawen on 20 December 1838. The parcel collateral was the land and buildings on which Sweatt resided in Boscawen containing six acres more or less and bounded easterly on Blackwater River, Southerly on land of Isaac Sweatt, westerly on a Hihway and Northerly on land of Richard P. Shattuck reserving the same privilege to Silas Sweatt as is reserved in my deed from him.¹⁴⁰
